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			All forms of bid security are acceptable however if the Bidder opts to submit a Surety Bond it must be callable on demand and must be accompanied by (1) Certificate of Authority from the Insurance Commission authorizing the Insurance/Finance Company to issue such bond and (2) another Certification for the surety bond from the Insurance Commission for bidding purpose of the specific project. A new form of bid security which is Bid Securing Declaration is acceptable, pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 03-2012 dated January 27, 2012.
			Proper tabbing of bid documents must be observed by the bidders.
			> The bidders are advised to observe the Bid Prices found in the ITB Clause 15.
			The bidders are advised to observe the Format and Signing of Bids found in the ITB Clause 19.
			The bidders are advised to observe the Sealing and Marking of Bids found in the ITB Clause 20.
