Subject: PR No. 24-0232 – Proposed 300 Cu.M. Reinforcement Concrete Ground Tanks at Baluno & Bandera-Dulian for Dumalon Water System

This SUPPLEMENTAL BID BULLETIN is issued to clarify, modify, or amend items in the issued Bidding Documents for the above-subject procurement in view of the **Pre-Bid Conference** last December 06, 2024, at the Board Room, 2nd Floor, ZCWD Bldg., Pilar Street, Zamboanga City and via Zoom Video Conferencing.

This Supplemental is issued in line with Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Circular 02-2018 (March 9, 2018) to ***“minimize the occasions of bidders’ disqualification due to non-compliance with bidding requirements”*** particularly 4.2.2, which states, ***“The BAC shall likewise discuss the common reasons of bidders’ disqualifications based on its experiences in previous procurement projects. Accordingly, the BAC shall present and explain the ways to prevent similar occasions of disqualification.”***

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| ITB Clause 5.2 (Contracts similar to the Project) | Any projects that contain reinforced concrete tank component intended for potable or non-potable water system, regardless of volume or size, it may be an overhead or underground tank, shall be considered similar to the Project. |
| Acquisition of Right-of-Way or location | <p>ZCWD is still processing the acquisition of right-of-way/location with the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) of the Department of Environment & Natural Resources (DENR) since the two tanks will be constructed within the buffer zones of the strict protected areas.</p> <p>With this, section 17.6 of IRR of RA 9184 states that xxxxx In case of projects with pending acquisition of right-of-way site or location, the procurement process may commence, <u>but no award of contract shall be made until an authority or permit to enter is issued by the property owner or a notarized deed of sale or deed of donation is executed in favor of the government; or a writ of possession is issued by a court or competent jurisdiction, as the case may be.</u></p> |

Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents

I. TECHNICAL COMPONENT ENVELOPE

Class "A" Documents

Legal Documents

- (a) Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages) in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR;

Technical Documents

- (b) Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; **and**
- (c) Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided under the rules; **and**
- (d) Special PCAB License in case of Joint Ventures **and** registration for the type and cost of the contract to be bid; **and**
- (e) Original copy of Bid Security. If in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission **or** original copy of Notarized Bid Securing Declaration; **and**
- (f) Project Requirements, which shall include the following:
 - a. Organizational chart for the contract to be bid;
 - b. List of contractor's key personnel (*e.g.*, Project Manager, Project Engineers, Materials Engineers, and Foremen), to be assigned to the contract to be bid, with their complete qualification and experience data;
 - c. List of contractor's major equipment units, which are owned, leased, and/or under purchase agreements, supported by proof of ownership or certification of availability of equipment from the equipment lessor/vendor for the duration of the project, as the case may be; **and**
- (g) Original duly signed Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) **and** if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.

Financial Documents

- (h) The prospective bidder's computation of Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC).

Class "B" Documents

- (i) If applicable, duly signed joint venture agreement (JVA) in accordance with RA No. 4566 and its IRR in case the joint venture is already in existence **or** duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful.

II. FINANCIAL COMPONENT ENVELOPE

- (j) Original of duly signed and accomplished Financial Bid Form; **and**

- (k) Original of duly signed Bid Prices in the Bill of Quantities; **and**
