		 Terms of Payment – We would like to confirm the applicable terms of payment for the contract, including payment schedule and conditions.
		The Payment Terms are specified in Clause 2 of the GCC and Clause 2.2 of the SCC in the Philippine Bidding Documents.
		 Sample Pictures – Would it be possible for us to obtain the required sample pictures within three (3) days?
		For reference, the images/pictures of the three items listed in this purchase requisition are attached to this addendum.
		Warranty – We would appreciate clarification on the warranty terms required for the items to be supplied.
		In accordance to Section 62 of the Updated 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 states: For the procurement of Goods, in order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the supplier, a warranty security shall be required from the contract awardee for a minimum period of three (3) months, in the case of Expendable Supplies, or a minimum period of one (1) year, in the case of Non-expendable Supplies, after acceptance by the Procuring Entity of the delivered supplies.

"Pursuant to Section 5.3(a) of the Instructions to Bidders in the Philippine Bidding Documents, the goods being procured are classified as Non-Expendable Supplies. Consequently, the warranty period applicable to Non-Expendable Supplies is one (1) year."

- Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) Please confirm if the required SLCC is at least 50% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC).
 - > The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

Requesting Entity: Cagayan Economic Zone Authority (CEZA)

Issues Concern: Origin of Goods

Details

Clarification on the existing procurement rules pertaining to the origin of goods relative to the authority secured by the CEZA from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) to purchase bulldozer which specifies that the country of origin should be from the G7 Countries only.

[P]rocuring entities are precluded from requiring specific country of origin as part of the technical specification for the project. Rather, the specifications shall be based on the performance requirements and recognized industry standards and not on the basis of country of origin.

- Submission Format We would like to confirm if the correct submission format is:
 - One (1) original copy
 - One (1) copy marked "Copy 1"
 - One (1) copy marked "Copy 2"

Or if the last one may be submitted electronically.
While not mandatory, the Procuring Entity prefers that each bidder submit one (1) original bid and two (2) copies, labeled as Copy 1 and Copy 2, each containing both the first and second components of their bid.

This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.
